First Summer Workshop

In this third year of the STEM Teaching Fellows program, participants will receive training and coaching on problem-based learning, inquiry teaching, cross-curriculum integration and technology integration. Working with leaders from business and post-secondary education, the fellows will develop STEM lessons and projects for immediate implementation in the classroom. Exposure to innovative instructional strategies and classroom tools will give them resources and ideas for their students and fellow colleagues.

Open to K-12 educators of all grade levels and subject areas
Application Deadline April 25th

Program requirements

- Summer Workshop #1 to be held May 29-30
- School letter of commitment agreeing to support 4 release days and substitute teacher costs submitted by June 25
- Summer Workshop #2 to be held July 21-22
- 4 one-day sessions during the school year, which will be scheduled based on input from the cohort

Financial Support

Schools of accepted STEM Teaching Fellow participants will receive \$1400 in financial support to assist with the teacher stipend, travel costs and substitute coverage for each participant enrolled in the program. To qualify for the STEM Teaching Fellow funding, schools must submit the letter of commitment by June 25.
